Communications Strategy August 2018

Purpose

To update and agree the communications strategy for providing information to the public regarding the ongoing plans and development of the Paddock Wood Community Centre project.

Need for update

The previous Communications Plan was adopted in September 2016, at the outset of the project. In the interim period Paddock Wood Town Council have agreed on the site of Memorial Field as the favoured option.

In recent months the project has attracted more attention and the Working Party have been attending community events to engage with the community and encourage discussion surrounding the plans to date. To further community engagement and involvement in the project is critical to reach support and ensure the building serves its' purpose as providing community space for all ages in the present and in the future as the town population is expected to grow.

Paddock Wood Town Council recognise the need to ensure clear communication across the community, to inform of progress and listen to comment. Information has been displayed across Town Council notice boards and in local written publications, but online information has been limited. Social media can be used to direct users towards the Town Council website for regular updates and notice of events and meetings.
