The Town Centre working group continues to focus on economic development. This month they discussed key infrastructure improvements which may be required to support economic development in the town. The discussion was far ranging and included matters such as adequate parking, additional accommodation eg a hotel or bed and breakfast, a transport hub, extra public transport, new access roads, a wider variety of small businesses, an evening economy and the expansion of the town centre. The idea of making Commercial Road one way to vehicles was again revived.
