



## We're upgrading our Gas Network - Warrington Road Area, Paddock Wood, Tonbridge

We are writing to let you know about our project to upgrade our gas network in the Warrington Road area of Paddock Wood. This work will upgrade our old metal gas mains and services with new plastic pipe. This essential work will ensure your community continues to receive a safe and reliable gas supply.

In consultation with Kent County Council our contractor, WCB Utilities who will be completing this project on our behalf, will start work in Warrington Road during the week beginning 12<sup>th</sup> June

Due to the position of the pipes in the road, and to ensure the safety of everyone around our worksite we will need to close some of the roads around our works area. While the roads are closed, there will be signed diversion routes in place and vehicular access will be maintained for residents and businesses where it is safe to do so.

The closures are currently programmed for the dates below, any changes to these will be publicised via <https://one.network/uk> and by advance warning signs placed at the closure points 2 weeks before work is due to start.

- **Warrington Road:** From week beginning 12<sup>th</sup> June with an estimated completion date of 29<sup>th</sup> September. We will be working from the junction with Maidstone Road to junction with Church Road. As our work moves along, we will also need to close each side road where they join Warrington Road to allow us to carry out connections to the newly laid pipe.
- **Tutsham Way:** From 11<sup>th</sup> September with an estimated completion date of 9<sup>th</sup> October. We will be working from outside 20 Tutsham Way to the junction with Ringden Avenue
- **Cogate Road:** From 11<sup>th</sup> September with an estimated completion date of 30<sup>th</sup> October. We will be working from outside 40 Cogate Road to the junction with Tutsham Way.
- **Church Road:** From 18<sup>th</sup> September with an estimated end date of 6<sup>th</sup> October. We will be working from outside 98 Church Road to the junction with Warrington Road.
- **Allington Road:** From 16<sup>th</sup> October with an estimated end date of 6<sup>th</sup> November. We will be working from the junction with Maidstone Road to outside 24 Allington Road.
- **Mount Pleasant:** From 16<sup>th</sup> October with an estimated end date of 6<sup>th</sup> November. We will be working at the junction of Allington Road.

We understand that people can get frustrated by roadworks, and therefore we only use traffic management that we feel is efficient enough to complete these works safely for ourselves and the public.

We're writing to residents and other local stakeholders to make them aware of our project and explain the details of our work. Please feel free to also share this information with anyone you think may be impacted by our project.
